DISCLOSURE STATEMENT GUIDELINES

Below is an example of the type of language to use, and information to provide, in the disclosure statement to a prospective buyer. It is intended as a guideline, not a requirement that you follow word for word. We do, however, ask that you adhere to the following:

- 1. When submitting a copy to the L&LMD No. 89-1-C, be sure to print it on Developer's letterhead
- 2. Be sure to include the case number(s) in the disclosure.
- 3. Be sure to indicate the service the L&LMD No. 89-1-C will be providing for the specific development. It is not necessary to list every service the L&LMD No. 89-1-C provides countywide, only those services that are applicable to the prospective buyer.
- 4. Be sure to leave a space to insert the amount of the assessment. When submitting your copy to the L&LMD No. 89-1-C you will not yet know what the annual assessment will be, however, when you present the disclosure statement to the prospective buyer the amount should be filled in.
