NO GRADING VERIFICATION

Building permit applications shall include sufficient site information in order to assist the Building Department in determining whether a grading permit is required. The requirement for grading verification will be determined using one of the following Options:

Option 1. Self-verification form <u>Number 284-152</u> is allowed for Residential buildings when:

1. The proposed residential structure is assigned one of the following permit types below and is <u>1,600 square feet in area or less (footprint)</u>:

BRS – Residential Building Structures

BXX – Residential Miscellaneous Structures **BMR** – Mobile Home Installations BAR – Residential Building Addition

- **BAS** Residential Accessory Structures
- 2. All of the items below must be true for approval of the NO-GRADING SELF-VERIFICATION
 - A. The structure is 1,600 square feet or less (footprint).
 - B. Less than 200 cubic yards of soils will be moved, excluding structural excavation (footings).
 - C. The site will have less than 12" of fill.
 - D. Cut slopes will not exceed five feet in height.

NOTE: The standards above apply to the proposed structure and driveway where applicable.

- **Option 2.** The applicant shall submit Grading plans, or may provide a copy of a previously finaled grading permit and two (2) copies of the previously approved plan showing pad for proposed building. A Precise Grading permit is required.
- **Option 3.** The applicant obtains a no Grading Verification Permit (**BHR-No Grading Verification**) and requests an inspection from Grading. Permit Fee: \$332.52

<u>Grading Verification Exhibits Requirements for Options 3:</u> The following information shall be on the Exhibit and also included with the building plans.

- a. Approved Land Use stamped site Plan with Building Permit Number
- b. 1) Two (2) exhibits required.
 - 2) Permit address.
 - 3) A North arrow.
 - 4) Location of proposed structure(s).
 - 5) Setback distances of structure(s) from the front, rear and side property lines.
 - 6) Driveway to the proposed structure(s).
 - 7) Show all areas to be disturbed including building area and driveway.
 - 8) Total disturbed area square footage.

Inspection Requirements for Option 3

Prior to the site verification inspection, the applicant and/or contractor shall provide the following building site identification at the property:

- 1) The site address assigned to the property shall be prominently posted on the site.
- 2) The location of the proposed structure(s) shall be clearly staked.
- 3) A site exhibit to be available on site for the site inspection (**see Grading Verification Exhibit Requirements**).

NOTE: In some instances the Inspector may not be able to determine if a grading permit is required. In such instances the site may require evaluation by a licensed Professional Engineer.
