HOMEOWNERS AND RENTERS ARE ADVISED THAT THE FOLLOWING RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED:

NOISE:

County Ordinance No. 847 regulating noise includes quiet hours between the hours of 10pm and 7am. No amplified sound may be audible inside a residence.

PARKING:

Renters and their guests should park in the rental garage, driveway, or on the property. No street parking will be permitted.

TRASH:

Trash and refuse shall not be stored within public view except in proper containers for collection.

DOGS:

All dogs are to be on leashes whenever they are in unenclosed areas. Barking dogs often result in neighbor complaints.

Failure to comply with the above may result in a citation, fines, or expulsion from the rental property for the renter or their guests.
